Core Responsibilities

- Provide carpentry services (framing and finish) at a Journeyman level
- Run jobs with minimal supervision with the ability to supervise a team on larger projects
- Read, interpret and work from blueprints, drawings, sketches and other specifications on a variety of structures related to the construction project
- Supervise and instruct Carpenter Apprentices and labourers
- Work with sub-trades in completing all projects
- Maintain a professional relationship with clients
- Complete required administrative duties
- Prepare layouts in conformance to building codes using measuring tools
- Fit and install trim items such as doors, stairs, moulding and hardware
